PICTURE 1

STORY: Chantra lives with his family. Here they are having lunch together. Even though his family has asked him to join them, he prefers to stay inside looking at his phone.



Discussion Questions

1. Why is Chantra keeping separate from his family?
2. How do you think his family feel?
3. What do you think Chantra should do?

Suggestions for Facilitator

Talk about the importance of talking together as a family and eating together.



PICTURE 2

STORY: Rather than playing with some of his old friends, Chantra has started looking at porn on his phone with some new friends.



Discussion Questions

1. What are Chantra and his friends choosing not to do?
2. Why are they doing it away from people?
3. Are they making a good choice?

Suggestions for Facilitator

Talk about the importance of playing with friends in a healthy way (e.g. playing sports to build relationships)



PICTURE 3

STORY: After school, Chantra and his friends spend time in an internet gaming shop playing games and connecting with others online who are playing games too



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What do children normally do at an internet gaming shop?
2. Do you think Chantra and his friends are making a good decision or not?
3. Why can gaming be dangerous?

SUGGESTIONS FOR FACILITATOR

**Talk about dangers and spending money in an internet gaming shop
E.g. Wasting time, wasting money, Connecting with people who are pretending to be kids but may want to harm you**



PICTURE 4

STORY: Watching a lot of porn is affecting his ability to concentrate and do well at school.



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Why is Chantra watching porn?
2. What are the consequences for Chantra being distracted?
3. What might his friend be thinking about him?

SUGGESTIONS FOR FACILITATOR

Talk about reasons why children watch porn and consequences of watching porn on their study and friendship (e.g. low marks, tiredness, feelings of guilt, frustration with self and others)



PICTURE 5

STORY: Chantra is very tired and sleepy but continues to stay up late watching porn.



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Why do you think Chantra has low marks?
2. Why does he keep looking at porn anyway?

SUGGESTIONS FOR FACILITATOR

Talk about how constantly watching pornography that can become a bad habit to overcome.



PICTURE 6

STORY: Nary catches Chantra looking at porn pictures on his phone. She is very uneasy and asks why he is looking at them. He sees that she is unhappy and he feels a little ashamed – he loves his sister and doesn't want to upset her.



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Why is Nary feeling uneasy and unhappy?
2. Why is Chantra feeling ashamed?

SUGGESTIONS FOR FACILITATOR

Talk about the feelings of Chantra, Nary and Rith, and why they are feeling this way.



PICTURE 7

STORY: Rith is also concerned about Chantra. He explains to Chantra about the dangers looking at porn and gaming can have on him. Chantra starts to think about all of this.



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What are the dangers of porn and its consequences?
2. How does it make you feel about your body and other people's bodies?
3. What are the ways that children can access porn?

SUGGESTIONS FOR FACILITATOR

Talk about how badly girls and boys are displayed in porn, that can make us feel bad about ourselves and can make us think and see other people's bodies in an unhealthy way, too.



PICTURE 8

STORY: Even though Chantra has heard about the dangers of porn, he still goes to his friend's house to watch porn on a DVD.



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Even though Rith has talked to Chantra about porn, why might it be hard for him to stop watching it?

SUGGESTIONS FOR FACILITATOR

Talk about peer pressure.
Overcoming the habit of watching porn frequently will probably take time.



PICTURE 9

STORY: As the beer takes effect the boys talk foolishly and laugh at the women in the films they've just watched, and start talking about girls they know. Suddenly one of them says to Chantra, 'Your sister is sexy. Let's take a video of her on our phone!'



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Why do you think the boys are speaking about Chantra's sister in that way?
2. Do you think porn is a good teacher of sex and why?
3. What do you think Chantra will do?

SUGGESTIONS FOR FACILITATOR

Talk about respect for women and about learning about sex and relationship in a healthy way (e.g. learning from a teacher or parent)



PICTURE 10

STORY: Chantra is shocked and shouts angrily: ‘Don’t talk about my sister like that!’ He grabs the remote control and throws it on the floor. There is a big argument and Chantra realises that watching porn with these boys could lead to something really bad. So he runs off home feeling frustrated with his friends.



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Why is Chantra so angry?
2. What choices does he have now?

SUGGESTIONS FOR FACILITATOR

Talk about the characteristics of a good friend and a bad friend.



PICTURE 11

STORY: The next day Chantra realizes how foolish he and his friends have been and does not want to be thinking of girls in a bad way. He promises to Nary that he will try to quit looking at porn again which makes her happy.



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What encourages Chantra to quit watching porn?
2. What will help Chantra keep his promise to his sister?

SUGGESTIONS FOR FACILITATOR

Talk about learning from mistakes, and apologising



PICTURE 12

STORY: Then next day Nary comes to Chandra because she is upset.
A boy at school sent her a Sext message with a naked picture. She doesn't know what to do!

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Why is Nary upset?
2. What choices does Chandra have now?

SUGGESTIONS FOR FACILITATOR

Talk about the characteristics of a good brother and sister.



PICTURE 13

STORY: Chantra tells his dad what has happened. His dad calls the dad of the boy who sent the picture and says to him that his son's behaviour is unacceptable so that that dad can talk to his son and make sure he doesn't do it again

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Why Chantra right to tell his dad?**
- 2. How can Chantra support his sister now?**

SUGGESTIONS FOR FACILITATOR

Talk together about why Sending naked pictures (sexting) is wrong and can be harmful to both children.



PICTURE 14

STORY:

Chantra tells Rith what has happened and how shocked he was. Rith then explains to him how porn can lead to a bad habit and there are bad people who trick, bully or force girls and boys into making porn. Chantra believes Rith and says, 'No one else has explained to me about porn or sex – maybe we could ask someone else who understands about it?'

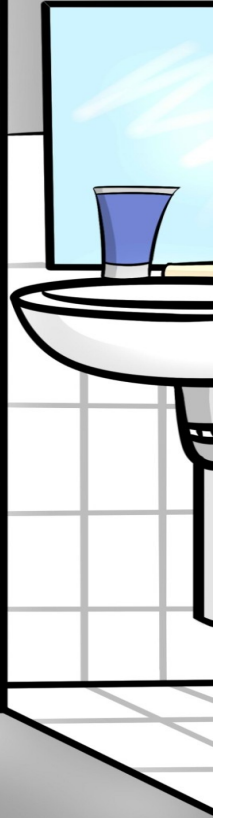
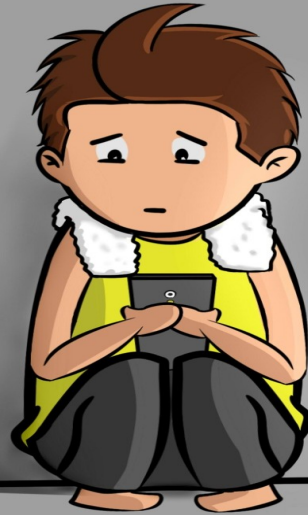
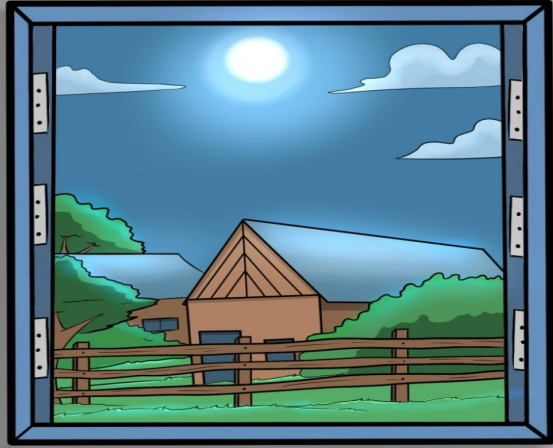


DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What factors motivate Chantra to not watch porn?
2. Who are some other people that Chantra can speak with to help motivate him to not watch porn?

SUGGESTIONS FOR FACILITATOR

Talk about encouraging friends who are struggling and about being committed to helping each other.



PICTURE 15

STORY: Chantra has just finished showering and is getting ready for bed. He sees his phone and realizes that now he is alone, he could watch porn and no one would know. But he also wants to stop watching porn and be free of it.



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. How can Chantra help himself in a moment like this?
2. In spite of everything that's happened and been said to him, why do you think Chantra is still drawn to watching porn?

SUGGESTIONS FOR FACILITATOR

Talk about the issue of porn addiction and the commitment to overcoming the issue (e.g. seeking help, calling the Child Helpline 1280)



6PICTURE 16

STORY: In his struggle, he remembers his promise to his sister and the advice his brother has given him. Knowing it is not only for him but his own family, Chantra resists the urge, turns off his phone and tries to get to sleep.



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Chantra knows that his decision is not for him, but also for others. Who would you think of when you were in Chantra's difficult situation?**
- 2. Is there anything else that can help Chantra to stop thinking about porn?**

SUGGESTIONS FOR FACILITATOR

Talk about five people that they love and care for.



PICTURE 17

STORY: Chantra is thinking of a person he wants to meet to talk about his struggling, then his uncle comes to his mind that he thinks is a safe person.



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Who would you go to, to talk about if you had a problem similar to Chantra?

SUGGESTIONS FOR FACILITATOR

Talk about the characteristics of a safe person (e.g. trustworthy, caring, respectful, available, supporting)



PICTURE 18

STORY:

Though not always easy, with help Chantra is able to quit porn and thrives once again at school and enjoys life with his family and friends.



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Chantra is now free to enjoy his life without the distraction of porn. What are the things in life that you really enjoy?
2. What is your dream and what steps are you making towards it? What help do you need in making those steps?

SUGGESTIONS FOR FACILITATOR

Encourage children to try to achieve their dream for their future (e.g. asking them to draw about what they want to do in the future)



PICTURE 19

STORY:

He is also able to help other boys be strong and not watch porn because of his experience and the freedom he now enjoys.



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Chantra's struggles can now be used for a good purpose in helping others. What do you think he will say to the boys?
2. What is the most important lesson you've learnt from Chantra's story?

SUGGESTIONS FOR FACILITATOR

Talk about the importance of helping your friends when they are struggling with their problem.
